Dorothy Day wanted to help people who were homeless or hungry. She stood up for peace and against injustice. She started a soup kitchen to feed the poor in New York City. Following her example, people in other cities started soup kitchens to help the poor. Under her leadership, the Catholic Worker Movement grew. This group of people joins together to feed hungry people, to work for greater justice, and to continue the work of Jesus in the world.
